Despite COVID, 2021 was a remarkable year for Hope Health Clinic! We continued seeing existing patients, however, we saw more new patients in 2021 than in 2020! We were blessed to remain open during the pandemic to continue providing quality healthcare. That is a testament to the commitment and compassion of our partner agencies, our financial supporters, staff, and volunteers.

It was September 2011 when we first opened our doors and began treating adults who were without insurance. Today, we now see individuals aged 4 and up. Most of our patients are without insurance, but we are also seeing many patients who are unable to use their insurance due to high deductibles and are essential without access to healthcare. During these last ten years, more than 5,000 individuals sought and received care at the Hope Health Clinic, and this represents more than 50,000 patient visits. These past 10 years have been filled with many blessings and exciting changes, but we are still looking to the future. We need to know what needs to be accomplished to continue meeting the needs of our patients, and creating more capacity for additional patients and services. Our Board is evaluating options available to the clinic to increase space but also add dental services. As our sphere of influence continues to expand to more counties, our need is growing and not decreasing. We look forward to sharing more with you as we celebrate the past 10 years and look forward to many more years in the future!

I think we can all say that 2021 was not what anyone expected. COVD 19 affected every facet of our lives, and it did not leave non-profit organizations untouched. The good news is that Hope Health Clinic managed to meet every challenge and thanks to generous donors, we were able to pay our staff and function almost as normal. One of the biggest challenges we had was the loss of many of our older volunteers. Most of these volunteers have not returned and because our model has always been almost all volunteers, we had to adapt. Hours of operations were reduced so that patients could be accommodated with reduced volunteer nurses and front desk personnel. However, the patients continued to come to this, their medical home, for their healthcare needs. As we look to the future, we realize that we may have to move toward having more paid staff.

Board meetings continued, but through ZOOM and that adaptation has caused us to rethink how meetings in the future might be conducted to better accommodate busy board members. Planned contacts with future Board candidates had to be tabled leaving us with an imperative to find new members as many of our senior leadership reach term limits. Even with the challenges, however, the Board is confident that as Hope Health Clinic enters its 10th year, Hope Health Clinic is still very much needed to serve the needs of our disadvantaged community members who otherwise would not have access to healthcare. As always, the Board thanks you for your support over the years.

Safety Net

- For patients who lose government or private insurance
- For those who have unaffordable deductibles
- For those who are unable to find a medical provider to accept their insurance (only 2% of our patient base has insurance and often cannot use their policy.

Inability to Work reduces overall stability of family (rent. utilities. food. etc.)



Why Did It Matter & What Impact Did We Have 2021

Over 50,000 patients visits since September, 2011

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Part-time Nurse Practitioners working 30 hours a week

HOPE HEALTH CLINIC'S MODEL OF CARE ALLOWS THE PATIENT TO TAKE AN ACTIVE ROLE IN THEIR HEALTH BY ACCEPTING CARE AND PAYING \$15 FOR A MEDICAL VISIT AND BASIC LAB WORK RANGING FROM \$8 TO \$9 PER PROCEDURE. DURING 2021, AROUND \$65,598 WAS CONTRIBUTED BY PATIENTS FOR SERVICES THEY RECIEVE AT HHC.


